

Letter postmarked Pembroke, North Carolina, 9/6/71, sent to Mrs. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., Atlanta, Ga.; a letter which contains obscene statements indicating that writer will Synopsis "slit your womb out before I kill you in Washington" and
"I'll kill your family before your eyes." DORA McDONALD,
Personal Secretary to CORETTA KING, received letter and did
not show it to Mrs. KING. She made letter available to FBI. McDONALD has no suspects.

This investigation is predicated upon the receipt of a letter in the Atlanta Division on September 16, 1971. This letter was sent to the Atlanta Division of the FBI by DORA McDONALD, Secretary to Mrs. CORETTA KING.

on September 16, 1971, a letter was received by mail at the Atlanta Office of the FBI in an envelope addressed to the FBI, Atlanta, Georgia. The envelope directed to the FBI contained a letter addressed to "Mrs. Martin Luther King (Coem), Atlanta University of Jews and Niggers, Atlanta, Georgia (Jew. A.). The envelope bears return address "Alexander Deas" and bears postmark "Pembroke, North Carolina."

The letter enclosed in the envelope begins "Coretta Coon, " and is signed "Alexander." It contains obsernities and a threat to kill the recipient of the letter.

Mrs. DCRA McDONALD telephonically advised that she is Personal Secretary to Mrs. CORETTA KING, the recipient of this letter, and stated that she had opened the letter and then forwarded it to the FBI by mail in view of the threatening nature of the letter.

Mrs. DORA MeDCHALD was contacted telephonically and stated she wished to furnish information telephonically. She added that she is a personal secretary to Mrs. CORETTA KING and was formerly the secretary of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., deceased, former President of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference. Miss McDONALD stated that sometime around September 8 or 9, a letter was received addressed to Mrs. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., and the employed entained a reference to Jews and Miggers. She opened this letter and noted that it contained threats and obscene Language. She stated that she showed this letter to leave and Miggers, and Tolking an afficial of the Southern Leadership Conference, and YOUNG, an afficial of the Southern Leadership Conference, and YOUNG anguested that the letter be made available to the FBI.

The letter begins "Corotta Coon" and contains numerous obscene references to her and her deceased husband. The letter also stated "I'm going to slit your womb out before I kill you in Washington some 20 years from now, Coasta Coon, then I'll kill your family before your eyes." The letter also makes reference to the Ku Klux Klan and also contains the statement "You will die Gonatta Coon because we will kill all the Goddamn Jews and Riggers." Miss McDWALD stated that Mrs. KING receives Dimerous crank letters, including letters offering professed of marriage. She stated that Mrs. KING is not sware of the identity of myone who would write such a letter. Miss McDCMALD added that meither she nor ANDREW YOUNG has any suspects.

ANDREW JOCKSON YOUNG and he was born Mark 12, 1912, in New Orleans, Louisiana. He has her several agreets in connection with recial demonstrations.


