This version seems to me to be much better than the preceding ones: it is generally clear and concise and it covers the ground pretty well for a preliminary publication. I have let Macquar read it, since he is chairman of the Subcommittee on Publications of the Faculty Committee on the Taft Memorial Fund, and he thinks it O.K. - You will note that I have put a few queries in the margin: they refer <sup>mainly</sup> to minor verbal matters or order of words. A Purist, for example, might object to a superlative of full.

Since your introduction is not quite 7 pages long and my foreword only 3 1/2, it may be - if the Press is allowing us 8 printed pages - that you could have a little more space

in case you should want to discuss briefly some of the  
matters you mention as being omitted. But perhaps it  
isn't necessary. — If there is a page to spare we  
might use it for a simple dedication "To the memory of  
K. Kononov" and strike out that last paragraph in  
the forward. — Speaking of the latter, by the way, is the  
statement in it correct that we got the enlarged prints  
in the winter of 1946-47? I can't remember.

This has been a very busy week with many demands  
on my time. The new McKim Hall was dedicated yesterday.

I am planning to take off for Greece on May 13  
after the meeting of the Managing Committee in New York.

We have finished the index to Trav, Vol. I and sent it to  
the Press, so that volume is now out of our hands.
