



SENATOR KENNEDY - VICTIM; JACQUELINE ONASSIS - VICTIM: CORRETTA KING - VICTIM has no local arrest record and is unknown to the Police Denartment in Chester. is not dangerous or violent, and has no firearms or dangerous weapons. He is a prolific letter writer On April 2, 1973, the facts involved in this matter were discussed with Assistant U. S. Attorney John F. Penrose, Eastern District of Pennsylvania, for the purpose of obtaining a prosecutive opinion. Mr. Penrose declined authorization of prosecution based upon investigation to date reflecting a long history of such activity by the subject. There was no indication of any overt acts and no local rrrest record. It was noted that he has been a prolific letter writer without any known harmful or aggressive activity. Attached are results of interviews concerning
