WHEREAS, During the summer and winter months, seating in the exterior patio areas becomes underutilized often due to weather conditions; and, therefore be it

RESOLVED, The University of Texas at Austin Student Government supports adding more interior and exterior seating to the Student Activity Center (SAC), including but not limited to the area in front of the SAC Ballroom, the area in front of the Senate of College Councils and Student Government Office, the area in front of the Legislative Assembly Room and by adding a patio deck to the south side of the Student Activity Center (SAC); and, be it

RESOLVED, The University of Texas at Austin Student Government supports conducting a feasibility study to repurpose a meeting room on the third floor of the Student Activity Center (SAC) to a student lounge with open access to the outdoor patio; and, be it

RESOLVED, The University of Texas at Austin Student Government supports decreasing the wait times of dining options; and, be it

RESOLVED, The University of Texas at Austin Student Government supports adding more UT branding, including the Texas Longhorn and Burnt Orange color² to the Student Activity Center (SAC); and, be it

RESOLVED, The University of Texas at Austin Student Government supports adding energy efficient electrical heating and cooling units to the exterior patio space; and, be it further
