WHEREAS, the Little Campus Admissions Building is the center of SHARE (Students Helping Admissions Recruitment Efforts), a program dedicated to minority recruitment and retention, now

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS that

the Students' Association recommend to the UT System Board of Regents that the Little Campus Admission Building be renamed the Hemann Sweatt Admission Building.
