- C. In Section 2 the phrase for other recognized organnations is meant to include oil companies.

- E. Minor changes in wording were take at the AVP meeting, the general intent being to keep these springstions off the desk of the decretary of the interior.
- F. These provided rules have been vetted by two law school professors.
