SUBJECT: FURTHER DEVELOPMENTS IN BERLIN AND GDR

1. THE FOLLOWING DEVELOPMENTS RELATING TO EVENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA OCCURED IN EAST BERLIN AND SUPPLEMENT INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE REFTELS.

2. MISSION PERSONNEL TRAVELLING IN EAST BERLIN DURING THE DAY NOTED THAT THE STREETS WERE SOMEWHAT MORE CROWDED THAN NORMAL BUT THAT THE ATMOSPHERE WAS QUIET. WHEREAS

THE STRENGTH OF EAST GERMAN BORDER PATROLS ON THE EAST
BERLIN WEST BERLIN BORDERS HAS BEEN DOUBLED BY THE REGIME,
THERE WERE NO VISIBLE SIGNS OF INCREASED POLICE ACTIVITY IN
THE CENTRAL PART OF EAST BERLIN ITSELF.

3. THE REUTERS CORRESPONDENT IN EAST BERLIN REPORTS THAT EARLY IN THE DAY THERE WAS A LARGE CROWD OF CZECHS WHO WERE BARRED FROM ACCESS TO THE CZECH EMBASSY BY EAST GERMAN GUARDS AND THAT SOME SHOVING OCCURED. SUBSEQUENTLY, SEVERAL CZECHS WERE REPORTEDLY GIVEN PERMISSION TO ENTER THE EMBASSY FOLLOWING AN ORAL PROTEST BY THE EMBASSY. THE REST WERE TOLD BY THE EAST BERLIN POLICE TO WAIT IN A BUILDING ACROSS THE STREET FROM THE EMBASSY. A BRITISH MISSION OFFICER WHO WAS IN THE VICINITY LATER IN THE DAY NOTED THAT THERE WERE ONLY VERY FEW PEOPLE IN THE AREA. IN GENERAL, EAST BERLIN WAS QUITE CALM.

4. THE REUTERS CORRESPONDENT WAS TOLD IN THE CZECH EMBASSY THAT A PARTY PROTEST HAD BEEN DELIVERED ON THE INVASION AND THAT A GOVERNMENT PROTEST WAS TO BE DELIVERED AT 3:00 THIS AFTERNOON. WHEN HE ASKED IF THIS MEANT THAT THE DUBCEK GOVERNMENT WAS STILL FUNCTIONING, HE DID NOT GET A CLEAR REPLY.

5. USBER OFFICERS SPOKE TODAY WITH A MEMBER OF THE CZECH MILITARY MISSION IN WEST BERLIN. HE WAS VISIBLY SHAKEN BY THE INVASION AND SAID THAT IT WAS BEYOND HIS COMPREHEN-SION. HE EXPRESSED DISMAY THAT CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S "ALLIES" COULD HAVE UNDERTAKEN SUCH A STEP. HE SAID TELEPHONE CONNECTIONS BETWEEN THE MISSION AND PRAGUE WERE CUT AS OF 10:00 THIS MORNING AND THAT THE FOREIGN MINISTRY WAS OCCUPIED. HE STATED THAT EAST GERMAN GUARDS AT CHECKPOINT CHARLIE WERE BEING EXTREMELY POLITE TO MEMBERS OF THE CZECH MILITARY MISSION AND EMBASSY IN EAST BERLIN WHO PASSED THROUGH THE CHECKPOINT. HE SAID AT THE SAME TIME THE EAST GERMANS WERE NOT PERMITTING CZECHS, INCLUDING DIPLOMATS, TO TRAVEL OUT OF EAST BERLIN TOWARD CZECHOSLOVAKIA. HE EXPRESSED THE OPINION THAT ULBRICHT HAD PLAYED A MAJOR ROLE IN THE DECISION TO INTERVENE MILITARILY, AND ADDED THAT NEITHER THE TASS NOR GDR STATEMENTS INDICATED WHICH LEADERS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAD ASKED FOR WARSAW PACT ASSISTANCE. HE SAID VEHEMENTLY THAT NOVOTNY COULD NEVER BE RETURNED TO POWER; THIS SAME

OPINION WAS EXPRESSED TO THE REUTHERS MAN IN THE CZECH EMBASSY IN EAST BERLIN.

6. A MEMBER OF THE SOVIET EMBASSY IN EAST BERLIN, WHO HAS PREVIOUSLY PROVIDED ACCURATE INFORMATION, TOLD A SPIEGEL CORRESPONDENT THAT EAST GERMAN TROOPS HAD NOT ACTUALLY ENTERED CZECHOSLOVAKIA, BUT WERE RIGHT UP ON THE BORDER. THE SOVIET OFFICER ALSO SAID THERE WOULD DEFINITELY BE A NEW GOVERNMENT IN PRAGUE BUT GAVE NO NAMES.
