BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT AUSTIN STUDENT GOVERNMENT:

SEC 1: Amend Title II, Article I, Sec. 4.9 in The Code of Rules and Procedures as follows:

Improve UT Challenge Agency

SEC 2: Add Sec. 4.32 in Title II, Article I of The Code of Rules and Procedures as follows:

Sec. 4. 32 **Improve UT Challenge Agency**

- a. Purpose. The purpose of the *Improve UT Challenge Agency* is to provide students an avenue to present creative initiatives to improve campus and work with administrators directly to implement them. This challenge connects students to resources and administrators needed to implement change on campus, that are typically only accessible through Student Government.
- b. Agency Structure.
 - i. The Improve UT Challenge Agency shall have two Co-Directors who are selected by the Student Government Executive Board.
 - ii. The Improve UT Challenge Agency Directors shall report directly to their respective Exec Board member.
- c. Executive Committee.
 - i. The Improve UT Challenge Agency shall be led by the Co-Directors and consist of up to five coordinators.
 - a. Coordinator - Work with Improve UT Co-Directors on outreach efforts to garner a large applicant base for the Improve UT Challenge for the first half of the year, and work with winners, administrators, and co-directors to implement the winning idea for second half of the year.
- d. Members. The Agency may add members with majority approval of the Executive Committee according to UTSG governing documents.
- e. Strategic Partners. The Office of the VPSA and the Office of the President will serve as the Strategic Partners for the Improve UT Challenge.
- f. Standing Events. The Improve UT Challenge Agency shall coordinate the annual or semi-annual Improve UT Challenge. Additionally, the agency will coordinate supplementary events as it sees fit leading up to the finalist round of the challenge.

SEC 2: This bill shall be sent to the Dean of Students, the Deputy Advisory to the Dean of Students and the Vice President of Student Affairs. This bill shall take immediate effect until and unless one or more of those entities objects.

SEC 3: The Assembly Clerk shall update the Code of Rules and Procedures and provide an electronic copy to the Communications Director, who shall update the SG website accordingly.
