Dear Brice,

I owe you a very great apology. In *Minos* VI p. 21 n. 3 I refer to Bennett as having joined HT 95 - HT 113 bis/149, & Chadwick has pointed out to me in perplexity that this join is not to be found in the Bennett's *Minos* corrections. I now remember the truth & even my own congratulations to you on the join. The reason, which doesn't matter, is that I had noted down "joined by B." !! & in fact the tablet is stuck together now at Herakleion like Bennett's own joins. I am terribly sorry & shall send a {+apology} corrigendum to *MINOS*, as well as if there is anything else you would like me to say, please write.

For example would you like to send them a (or me for transmission) a transcript of the tablet as it is now joined.

There is another thing I have been intending to write to you about. I am about to publish (in July or so) a working edition of Linear A + indices & dictionary to incorporate my own readings etc. I made at Heraklion & elsewhere. Now there are one or two inscriptions I have only seen in your proof of SM III viz.
