INDIAN JOINT WAR COMMUNIQUE NO.169

The following communique was received in London from India this morning:-

Yesterday afternoon June 28, a formation of R.A.F. Wellington bombers made a medium height attack on Akyab where a considerable number of Japanese troops are stationed.

A good weight of bombs was dropped, and bursts were observed throughout the target area.

In the morning, other bombers attacked enemy hutments near Mychaung.

Beaufighters and Hurricanes attacked supply sampans and other water transport on the Irrawaddy and Kaladan rivers. About fifty sampans, some sandoway boats and a river steamer were damaged, and attacks were also made on oil installations at Chauk.

None of our aircraft is missing.
