TOYS FOR CHRISTMAS

The Board of Trade announce that they have issued a General Licence under the Limitation of Supplies (Miscellaneous) (No. 21) Order, permitting manufacturers and wholesalers registered in Class 13 to supply an additional quantity of toys and children's indoor games equal in value to 25% of their quota for that class. These extra supplies must be made between September 13 and November 30 so that they may be available for the Christmas trade. The value of the cheaper type of goods supplied (not exceeding 5/- ex manufacturer) may be halved, as for ordinary quota purposes.

The intention of the Board in making this concession is to allow release of any stocks of controlled goods which may be available or which can be made from material already in the manufacturers' possession. It should be particularly noted that no additional raw material can be released for the production of goods to be supplied under this licence.
