Dear Dr. Stenzel:-

Time and patience have at last led us to a lovely summer cottage here on the island of Sjælland (Zealand) about 30 miles S of Copenhagen. I shall begin field work all over Denmark's islands in the Maestrichtian-Danian-Paleocene & Eocene. I shall begin by consulting with Dr. Rosenkrantz at the Univ. and several others at the Survey & then spend 3 weeks in the field. I shall remember you when the material is collected & prepared - as I promised a year ago. Scarcely seems possible that a year has passed since we finally brought to a successful conclusion - (my thesis).

I have spent the day with Dr. Rosenkrantz at the University going over maps - sections - literature and am now ready to begin collecting in the field.

I bought a 1939 DKW (German car) - 2 cylinders (!) - last month and am using it now in my field work. It has been a wonderful car - having taken me to Oslo two weeks ago & then all over the province of Västergötland on a E-Ord-Sil. field trip of 4 days with Dr. Hesseland. After 3

months here in Denmark it will take us to Hannover, East and to Brussels (we hope). There I shall meet with specialists in stracodes and fossils.

I have sleeping bags & a tent and will stay at quiet places on the outskirts of the cities we visit. Not many like us suppose, but we must economize where and we enjoy living out-of-doors as we travel.

My wife, at 6 months, is quite a traveler and seems to like it judging from the note we carried out on the way down to Copenhagen.

Dr. Rosenkrantz had nothing but praise for your Stone City Pelecypod paper and was very happy to receive some material from me. His collection from Greenland grows every day and he leaves again in 3 weeks for another summer field excursion there. He is preparing a monograph of the Lower Tertiary molluscs from Greenland - and it should be a wonderful work when finished. The illustrations I have seen are excellent.
