

Book Code

Explained on page 4

- *After the title of a book, indicates that the publisher of the book did not offer it for re-adoption at the time the contracts for other books on the multiple list were extended. This book is to be continued in use in those schools for which it was adopted.

Notes

Numbered notes referred to are those printed on page 3 and on the Annual Requisition forms.

TEXTBOOK QUOTA INFORMATION

- Requisitions may be made only for the books selected for use in the school system.

- The number of copies of all selected titles from a multiple list is to be considered in requisitioning additional copies of any book on the list.
- A school is not entitled to more than 110% of a basal title or 100% of a supplementary reader (including teachers' copies). A teacher is entitled to one book in each subject she teaches.
- Usable copies of one title on a multiple list may not be returned in order to secure copies of another title on the same list.
- Textbook contracts may include one or more of these teachers' materials for use with a title: teachers' editions to be purchased by the State; free teachers' edition or free manual, guide, etc.
 - Purchasable teachers' editions must be considered in the quota for the title and the multiple list.
 - Requisition for purchasable teachers' editions will be honored for a number of copies not to exceed the number of teachers for the subject; these editions will be charged to the quota for the title and the list.
 - No teachers' materials are supplied unless the pupils' edition is to be used.
 - Free materials are not charged to the school's inventory.

Normal Quota

The regular quota for basal textbooks is 100% of the grade membership for books used in grades 1 through 6 and 100% of the subject membership for books used in grades 7 through 12. Either the number of teachers or 10% may be added to the membership figure in determining textbook requests. Annual requisitions are based on projected membership figures; Supplemental Requisitions made after school starts are based on actual memberships.

The normal quota applies to a subject unless a special quota is indicated in the "Notes" column opposite the titles for the subject.

Special-Quota Notes

The numbered quotas below are based on membership plus 10% except for these subjects:

- first-grade music which is for teachers only
- supplementary readers which are allowed for actual membership only (teachers' editions of supplementary readers are deducted from pupils' quotas).
- dictionaries which are supplied on basis of actual membership only.
- 1. Pre-Primer Basal Readers -- 150% of grade one membership. (on by)
- 2. Supplementary Readers for Pre-Primer, Primer, and First Grade 300% of grade one membership (only) for
- 3. First-Grade Vocal Music -- Limited to teachers of vocal music in grade one.
- 4. Second-Grade Basal and Supplementary Readers -- Combined total of these two lists is not to exceed 400% of the grade membership with a limit of 100% on each level of basal readers and a limit of 300% on the total of supplementary readers.
- 5. Third-Grade Basal and Supplementary Readers -- Quota is the same as for the second grade.
- 6. Supplementary Readers for Fourth through Eighth Grade -- 200% of membership (only) in grade to which books are assigned.
- 7. Dictionaries for Grades Four through Seven -- 50% of combined membership (only) in these four grades. Titles on page 15 are supplied only for increased quota, increased membership or as replacements. Usable copies of books supplied prior to September, 1962, (see page 42) are to be continued in use.
- 8. U. S. History for Grades Five or Six -- Normal quota for one of these two grades.
- 9. Arithmetic and Jr. High-School Math for Grades Seven and Eight -- A pupil may be supplied with a book in either of these subjects, but not in both.
- 10. Elementary Spanish for Grades Three through Eight -- Books adopted for each year of elementary Spanish may be supplied on basis of normal quota at the particular level.
- 11. Spanish Dictionaries -- 30% of combined membership (only) in Spanish classes in three through eight.
- 12. H. S. Agriculture -- Combined total of books not to exceed normal quota based on 200% of the agriculture department membership.
- 13. Commercial Arithmetic -- Normal quota of subject membership.
- 14. Stenography - Normal quota based on the subject membership of a manual and also of the dictation book. Advanced Shorthand -- Normal quota of the subject membership for the transcription book and for the speedbuilding book.
- 15. Physical and Health Education Limited to normal quota based on grade nine membership.
 16. Eighth-Grade Dictionaries -- 150% of membership (only) in grade eight.
- 18. Vocal Music, Grade Four -- New contracts in this subject do not become effective until September, 1964. All books in the schools at the close of 1962-63 are to be continued in use until that time.
- 19. All copies of this teacher edition charged as of this inventory will remain charged until properly accounted for and will be part of your school's quota. Additional copies are to be requested on the Order Form for Teacher Aids.


- 20. Vocational Industrial Education books in a subject area may be supplied only to those schools currently approved for the specific area in either Cooperative Vocational Industrial Education or in Vocational Industrial Education.
- 21. Seventh-Grade Texas History -- Copies of the Texas Constitution may be supplied with an accompanying Texas-history order in the ratio of one Constitution to two copies of the textbook. These copies of the Constitution are to last for the duration of the contract period and are for use with seventh grade Texas history, high-school Texas history, and/or high school civics.
- 22. Mallory, Geometry -- "Supplemental on Solid Geometry" is supplied with each copy of this textbook. Whenever copies of A First Course in Geometry are returned, an equal number of the Supplemental is also to be returned.
- 23. Homemaking -- Combined total of books for the subject is not to exceed the normal quota based on 200% of the high-school homemaking department membership.
- 24. Industrial Arts -- The normal quota applies to each Industrial Arts subject based on the over-all membership for that subject in grades seven to twelve, inclusive, regardless of local grade placement of individual titles.

EXPLANATION OF TEXTBOOK CODE

All machine processing of textbook records is done according to the individual textbook codes rather than by book titles. Each State-adopted textbook is assigned an identifying number based on the code outlined below. No number will be duplicated even after the contract expires on the book to which it is presently assigned.

The textbook code consists of six digits. For most subjects the first four figures identify a multiple list and the last two digits a particular book on that list.

Assigned Grade Placement

The first digit of the code number indicates the grade or placement of the multiple list on which the book was adopted.

> - Books adopted for use below Grade 1 1 through 8 - Actual grade for which books are adopted

- Books adopted for use above Grade 8

Multiple lists that are adopted for use in two or more grades are coded for one grade only. The complete assigned placement is given in the explanatory note for the list.

The second and third digits identify the subject for which the book was adopted by the State Board of Education. See the next page for complete listing of subjects.

Level of Subject

The fourth digit shows the subject level of the book.

1, 2, etc. - First level or year of a subject, second level, etc. 3 - Readiness level -when used with a 0 grade 5 - Pre-Primer level 7 - Primer level

Book Number

The fifth and sixth digits represent a specific book on the multiple list.

Final date for submitting supplemental requisitions to correct number of worn-out and paid-for books reported on annual report if books are needed by September 1. These requisitions are to be submitted on Optical Scanning cards filed with Form Tex-033, Transmittal Form for Textbook Cards.

Except in case of unusual emergency, no supplemental requisition should be necessary if annual report was not filed until the close of school.
