- CHIEF OF PROTOCOL AND CHIEF SIXTH SECTION MFA INFORM ME THAT IT IS NOT REPEAT NOT POSSIBLE TO OBTAIN AGREMENT WITHIN. THREE DAYS.
- 2. THEY PROMISED TO DO ALL THAT CAN BE DONE TO OBTAIN AGREMENT IN SHORTEST POSSIBLE TIME. CHIEF OF PROTOCOL WITH WHOM I MET THIS AFTERNOON FOR A REPORT AFTER HE HAD HAD OPPORTUNITY TO CANVAS POSSIBILITIES FOLLOWING PRESENTATION THIS MORNING.

PAGE TWO RUFUPR. 216 CONFIDENTIAL INFORMED ME THAT HE ESTIMATES THAT A WEEK WILL BE REQUIRED TO GET . AGREMENT FROM PRESIDENTIAL PALACE.

- 3. HE SAID THAT SINCE RECEIVING EMBASSY' REQUEST FOR AGREMENT THE MFA HAD GIVEN IT PRIORITY TREATMENT WITH VIEW TO PRESENTING IT IN PROPER FORM AT PRESIDENT NOVOTNY'S OFFICE BY THIS EVENING (MAY 6).
- MFA OFFICIALS EXPLAIN THAT NORMALLY, UNDER CZECH PROCEDURFS. THREE WEEKS ARE REQUIRED TO OBTAIN PRESIDENTIAL APPROVAL OF AGRE-MENT REQUESTS AND THAT OUR REQUEST FOR THREE DAY APPROVAL CAME AT MOST DIFFICULT TIME. PRESIDENT NOVOTNY'S SCHEDULE, THEY SAID, IS OVERLOADED WITH MEETINGS, SPEECHES AND OTHER COMMITTMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THREE DAY CELEBRATIONS CULMINATING MAY 9 AND WITH PRESIDENT . S ROLE AS PARTY FIRST SECRETARY ON EVE

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- 5. OFFICIALS VOLUNTEERED THAT THEY UNDERSTOOD THE DESIRABILITY UNDER AMERICAN CONSTITUTIONAL SYSTEM OF MOVING MOST SPEEDILY ON DIPLOMATIC APPOINMENTS AND THAT CZECH GOVENMENT WISHED TO MEET OUR SPECIAL NEEDS TO FULLEST EXTENT POSSIBLE.
- 6. THEY SAID THEY APPRECIATED MUTUAL BENEFITS THAT MIGHT BE DERIVED FROM SHOWING A GENUINE DESIRE TO COMPLY WITH PRESIDENT

JOHNSON'S WISH AND THAT CZECH GOVERNMENT HAD NO INTENTION OF
STALLING OR DELAYING UNNECESSARILY ON AGREMENT. AND THEY
SAID THEY ALSO SAW ADVANTAGES TO CZECH SIDE IN BEING AS
FORTHCOMING AS CIRCUMSTANCES PERMIT. BUT AT SAME TIME THEY
EXPRESSED HOPE THAT USG WOULD BE AS UNDERSTANDING AS POSSIBLE
OF PROBLEMS ON THEIR SIDE. A FIXED AND WELL-SETTLED TRADITION
AND PROCEDURE FOR PROCESSING AGREMENT REQUESTS EXISTS. ETC.

- 7. OFFICIALS SAID THAT BIOGRAPHIC INFORMATION PROVIDED ON MR. BEAM WAS AMPLE AND FULLY SHOWED HIS HIGH QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND THAT THERE CERTAINLY WAS NO INTENT OR NEFD ON CZECH SIDE TO TRY TO GO BEHIND INFORMATION ALREADY PROVIDED.
- 8. IN SUMMING UP, MFA OFFICIALS SAID THEY HOPED EMBASSY COULD BE GIVEN AGREMENT BY MAY 13 BUT THAT EVEN THIS COULD NOT BE GUARANTEED. THEY PROMISED TO DO THEIR BEST AND MEANWHILE HOPED THAT NO REPEAT NO ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE APPOINTMENT WOULD BE MADE BY US GOVERNMENT SINCE THIS WOULD COMPLICATE WHAT NOW PROMISES TO BE AN EXCELLENT APPOINTMENT.
