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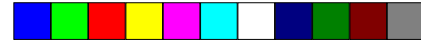

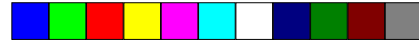

The bibliography is divided into subject areas that correspond to the Library’s classification system. Bibliographic descriptions (author, title, editor, etc.) are given for each reference. The call number is also included to find books on the shelves.

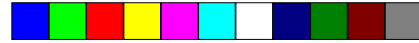

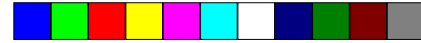
