

Dear Mr. President:

In compliance with Section 2(b)(2) of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945, as amended, this is to inform you that I have determined that it is in the national interest for the Export-Import Bank to extend guarantees, insurance, credits, and to participate in the extension of credits in connection with any transaction involving the exportation of United States products and services to Yugoslavia. The Bank will report the individual guarantees, insurance, credits, and participations in credits to the Congress as they are extended.
