Dear Mr. Stenzel,

we have received today the publications you sent, which followed of a few weeks your letters.

I thank you very much for your kindness in sending me so many works of yours, which will be very useful for the study I am doing on Miocene Aturias from the Piedmontese Basin. The one on living Nautilus is particularly interesting for my work, especially for the description of the test and siphuncle structures, and early ontogenetic features of the shell.

Professor Malaroda, the Director of this Institute of Geology, also thanks you very much for the second copy of each of your publications, which will be put in the Institute's library.

By separate mail we are sending you a work by Prof. Malaroda on the Tertiary fauna from Monte Postale, in which a new species of Aturia is described, with some other concerning Tertiary faunas.

Unhappily we have not available recent works on Coenozoic Crustacea. As for Bellardi's and Monterosato's works, we do not think that they are still available. On the contrary, some works of Sacco's are still available at Sacco's son, whose address is: Dott. Vittorio SACCO, Via Filippo Baldinucci 91, MILANO.

In any case, if some of these works which are not available interests you particularly, you might have it reproduced by microfilm. Naturally, when my work on Miocene Aturias will be published I'll send you a copy of it.

The treatise on marine Ecology & Paleoecology has been received by our Institute just some weeks ago, and I could read on it what was most interesting for my work.

I still thank you very much and hope that the material we are sending you will be interesting for your studies.
