In the course of a long conversation with Mr. Cook, he told me that a colleague of his in Paris had been informed by a Polish correspondent that Poland was concerned not only about the West German attitude to territorial problems but the East German attitude as well. He stated that Ulbricht had twice raised with Khrushchev the possibility of a return of Stettin to East Germany.
