THE BISCUITS (MAXIMUM PRICES) ORDER, 1943

With the object of providing an outlet for stocks of dry wafers which had accumulated following the ban placed upon the manufacture and sale of ice cream, the Biscuits (Maximum Retail Prices) Order, 1942, was amended on April 7, 1943, to make limited provision for the retail sale of such wafers to the public in accordance with prescribed maximum prices. This Order is now being withdrawn as the purpose for which it was issued has been served.

Two varieties of dry wafer will continue to be available for retail sale to the public and in the new Biscuits (Maximum Retail Prices) Order, 1943, which comes into operation on January 16, 1944, the following maximum retail prices have been fixed for the types specified viz:-

The new Order is being issued in consolidated form and replaces the Biscuits (Maximum Retail Prices) Order, 1942, and all amendments thereto.
