

LATEST GIFTS FROM THE COLONIES

STRAITS SETTLEMENTS

The proceeds of Straits Settlements War Savings Certificates for July to September amounted to \$2,003,139.

TANGANYIKA TERRITORY

The following allocations have been made by the Tanganyika War Relief and Welfare Fund: National Air Raid Distress Fund, £30; the Mayor of Southampton for air raid distress, £30; King George's Fund for Sailors, £100; Royal Air Force Benevolent Fund, £100.

BRITISH GUIANA

A fund established by the British Guiana Civil Service Association and extended to all people in receipt of emoluments from public funds has given £350 for the purchase, equipment and stocking of a mobile canteen to be used in any area in the United Kingdom.

NYASALAND

Nyasaland War Community Chest has allocated the following amounts: St. Dunstan's, £150; King George's Fund for Sailors, £100; sums paid to a fund for those disabled or bereaved by the war, £100; the Lord Mayor of London's National Air Raid Distress Fund, £205; Grimsby Fishermen's War Fund, £50; Royal Air Force Benevolent Fund, £30; Royal Air Force Comforts Association, £30.

BAHAMAS

A committee in the Bahamas dealing with war charities has sent a further sum of £150 towards King George's Fund for Sailors and £516.13.6. to the Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children.

The Bahamas Red Cross has raised £500 for the Duke of Gloucester's special Red Cross Aid to Russia Fund.

LEEWARD ISLANDS

A sum of £30 to provide comforts for civil defence workers has been received from the Montserrat (Leeward Islands) War Charities Committee. The warm thanks of His Majesty's Government have been conveyed to the Committee.

JAMAICA

Jamaica's Central War Assistance Committee has given a further £1,000 from the Mobile Canteen Fund. Of this amount, £400 is from the people of St. Catherine Parish and £250 from the Westermorland Parish.
