### Executive Summary

#### **A.B. 6: Amending The Code of Rules and Procedures to Create Representative Outreach**

##### **Credits**

This legislation requires representatives to “speaker circuit” to further the outreach programs of the Student Government Assembly. The hope is that these outreach activities will make contact with those people who would otherwise have no interest in hearing about Student Government initiatives. The hope is also that representatives are encouraged to develop their own individual initiatives, so they have material and progress to present to these organizations.

be registered and in good-standing with the Office of the Dean of Students. This requirement may not be fulfilled by addressing one's own college council. This requirement is instituted with the expectation that representatives serve a year-long term. Any representative that serves for a portion of a full term is required to present to at least one organization, ~~contribute three (3) hours in the Fall semester and two (2) hours in the Spring semester to a Student Government Event.~~

- i. Representatives will 1) contact the organization's presiding officer, 2) give a concise presentation on the initiatives they are pursuing in Student Government, and 3) explicitly ask the students in attendance what internal or campus-wide improvements Student Government should advocate. ~~This Student Government event shall be defined by tabling, volunteering, hosting, attending, or contributing to a Student Government affiliated event. Other events may be counted towards this requirement at the discretion of the Chair of the Ethics and Oversight Committee.~~
- ~~ii. The deadlines for Fall Semester hours shall be due by the last day of classes in the Fall by 11:59 p.m. and the Spring Semester hours shall be due by the first Friday of March by 11:59 p.m.~~
- iii. Representatives shall be required to provide proof of their presentation ~~involvement~~ and submit this by the end of the month they participated for it to count as credit. The Chair of the Ethics and Oversight Committee shall decide what proof is acceptable and how this is to be submitted. Submissions must be made within one month of participation.
- iv. Failure to complete the requirements above ~~contribute to a Student Government event by the deadlines~~ shall result in one half (0.5) of an absence per organization meeting ~~that a Representative fails to meet the minimum requirements.~~

SFC 2: This bill shall be sent to the Dean of Students, the Deputy Advisory to the Dean of Students and the Vice President of Student Affairs. This bill shall take immediate effect until and unless one or more of those entities objects.

SFC 3: The Assembly Clerk shall update the Code of Rules and Procedures and provide an electronic copy to the Communications Director, who shall update the SG website accordingly.
