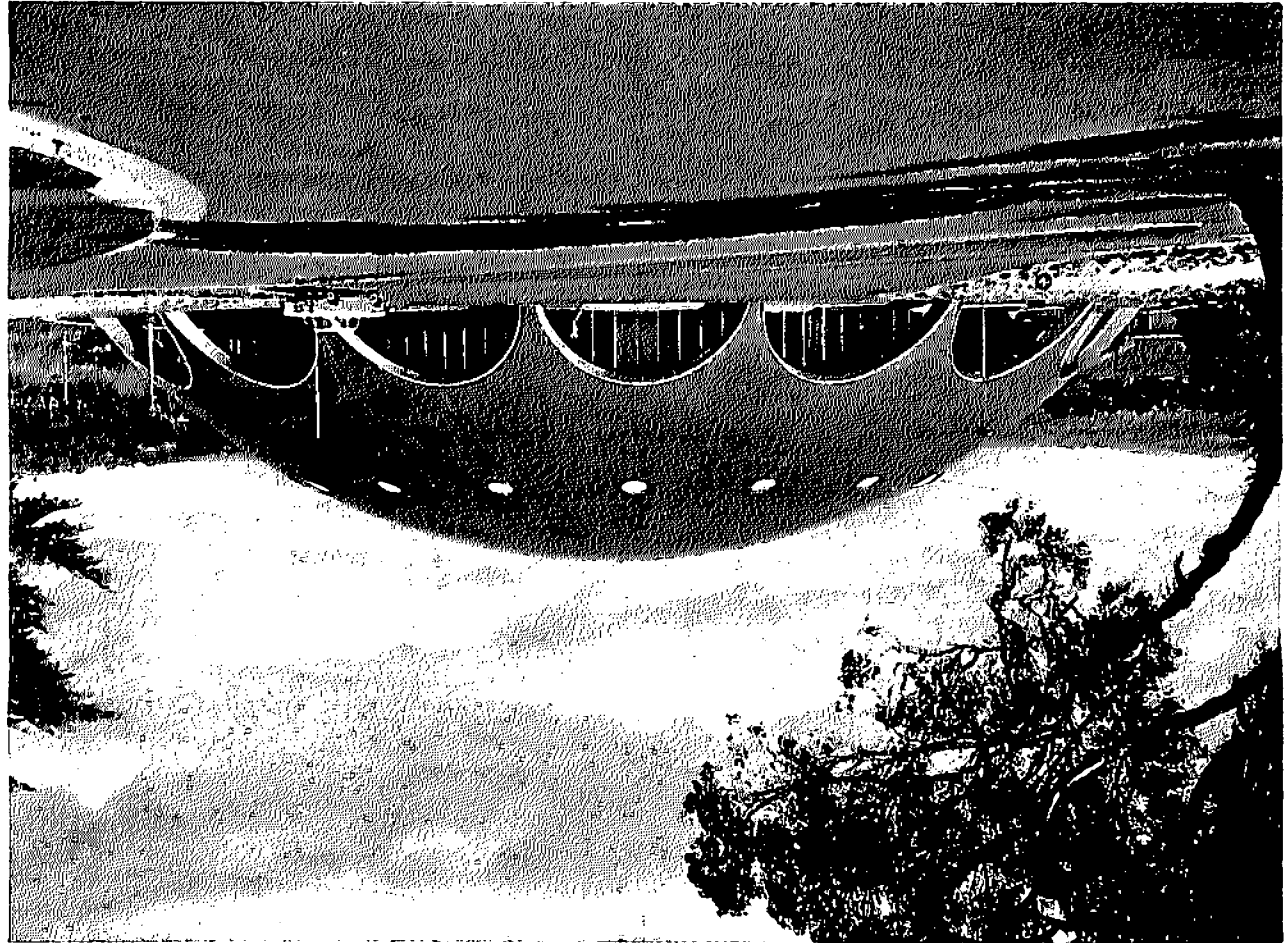
This is just a h
