CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. Annual Registration Fee:

Schools: NON-RENTAL, per school per school year......\$1.00 (All films with no price stated are non-rentals.)

GROUP RENTAL, per school per school year \$25.00 (Entitles patron to one day's use of all rental films marked with an asterisk (*), and five days' use of non-rental films marked with an asterisk (*).)

Clubs: Non-rental service, per service 25c. (Three reels or less.)
Rental films at prices listed in catalogue.

2. Time Loaned, Exclusive of Travel:

NON-RENTAL films loaned for five days or less.

RENTAL prices quoted in catalogue are for one day only; rental for each subsequent day is 50 per cent of the first day's rental, on all films renting for 50c or more. There is no reduction for subsequent days on films renting for less than 50c. Rental is charged for each day film is in hands of patron.

3. Prompt Return of Films:

Remember that films are booked for other patrons and must be returned promptly. Rental films kept overtime will be charged at the rate in the catalogue, non-rentals are 25c per reel per day for all overtime. This Bureau reserves the right to telegraph or telephone collect for overdue films.

4. Transportation:

Transportation costs both ways must be paid by the borrower.

5. Reports:

Reports must be sent promptly or this Bureau reserves the right to discontinue service.

6. Damage:

Loss or damage will be charged to the exhibitor. Reels must be kept intact, as received. Do not remove header or trailer to fasten reels together on one large reel. A charge of 25c will be made when a header or trailer is not returned. Return reel band with reel. Do not rewind after last showing.

7. Order Ten Days in Advance of Showing:

When ordering, state exact date for showing, and give first, second, and third choice of films or of dates for showing. This Bureau reserves the right to substitute on late orders.

8. Sound Films:

Sound films cannot be run on silent projectors. Therefore, sound films will be shipped only to patrons who state in their orders the make and model of the sound projector they are using.

9. Use:

Material sent from this Bureau must be shown free, unless admission charges or collections are used for some definite school purpose.

FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF SOUND-ON-FILM PROJECTION

Efficient projection of talking motion pictures depends on the careful handling of the sound film.

Caution. Never attempt to run a "sound" film on any other than a sound projector. Irreparable damage to sound film will result from running it on a "silent" projector.

The beam of light in the sound head is so fine, and the photoelectric cell so delicate, that every grain of dust on the sound track or the least scratch in the emulsion will cause magnified, unnatural noises and a distortion of the sound.

The film should never be pulled tight, or "cinched" on the reels. When this is done, each layer of film slides on the next and dust particles scratch the emulsion and damage the sound track.

Keep the film gate clean. As the film passes through the gate, a certain amount of emulsion is scraped off which, if allowed to accumulate, forms a hard scale on the guides. Sometimes the friction of this scale is so great that the perforations of the film are torn by the intermittent trying to feed the films thus tightly held.

When the film breaks. If the film should break stop the machine immediately to prevent injuring the film. Rethread the remaining portion, putting the tip end of the rethreaded part far enough under the loose end of the previously projected film on the take-up reel so that the loose end of the projected portion will lap over the tip at least one complete revolution of the lower reel, and thus hold it securely when the projector is started again.

Make no splices in sound films. Breaks in the films will be repaired by the Bureau, where the splices will be properly opaqued. Should the film be mutilated, return the damaged part with the reel, so that the Bureau can make replacement of the identical part, thereby keeping the continuity complete.

Never use bent or defective reels which may injure the sound track.

Be sure to read and preserve the book of instructions sent with your projector. Follow threading operations in every detail. Oil as directed. Failure to read and follow instructions causes trouble.

Reel 2 shows army encampment in Rumania, Rumanian village wedding, and making of mats and baskets from reeds grown in Danube swamps. Reel 3 shows supplies transported to oil fields by bullock wagons, field storage tanks of wood reinforced with reeds, gypsies, modern steel derricks at Balcoi field, Bustenari field with its many hand-dug wells, and women raising and lowering pipe by hand.

Reel 2 shows machining of castings; assembling of valves; steam testing for leakage; and wrapping for shipment. Close-up views of automobile engine, with cross sections of poppet, butterfly, check, and gate valves; show 27-foot butterfly valve, largest made, controlling flow of water to great turbogenerators at powerful Conowingo (Md.) hydro-electric plant; and depict passage of ship through Panama Canal with 7-foot gate valve regulating water level in locks. Reel 3 pictures Roosevelt irrigation dam in Arizona, where gate valves hold back water and feed it to farming projects in desert; scenes in Oklahoma oil field, where valves are used to bring gushing oil well under control and handle flow of oil through thousand-mile pipe lines; Bureau of Mines plant at Amarillo, Texas, where helium is extracted from natural gas and valves are indispensable in controlling separation of helium from natural gas and in storing separated helium in tanks while awaiting shipment: large dirigible landing in front of Capitol in Washington; and fire engine subduing flames that threaten building, showing important part of valves in fire fighting.

 Opens with familiar sight—boys watching cement being mixed. One of group later asks his father about Portland cement and is directed to consult encyclopedia. Succeeding scenes picture most important of 80 proc-

esses involved in cement manufacture as explained to

boy by manikin who steps from encyclopedia. Portland cement is defined and parallel drawn between bread making and cement making. Views follow of quarrying, loading, crushing, and grinding of limestone and preparation of clay, slag, and shale. Just as bread is baked to make it edible raw cement materials are "burned" in intense heat to produce clinker. Before use as cement the latter must, however, be ground and mixed with gypsum—a white material that regulates setting time. Tube mills are shown pulverizing mixture of clinker and gypsum fine enough to pass through seive that holds water. Device is shown picking up sample for testing, and typical laboratory scene follows: Reel concludes with final steps in preparing cement—tying and filling sacks.

*153 Evolution of the Oil Industry, The. 4 reels.

Reel 1 traces development of petroleum industry from earliest times and emphasizes importance of petroleum to modern civilization. Shows building of Noah's ark, construction of temples by disciples of Zoroaster over petroleum seepages where the sacred flames were worshipped, use of petroleum pitch and oil by Babylonians in defense of their cities, burning of petroleum in sacrificial rites of Central American Aztecs; and utilization of petroleum for medicinal purposes by American Indians. Presents details of bringing-in Drake well, first producing oil well in America in 1859.

Reel 2 shows pioneer days of the American oil industry—difficult transportation of crude oil over bad roads, by teams of horses and wagons, and on creeks by barges floated by spring freshets to the Allegheny River where steamers awaited cargoes; "spring-pole" method of drilling; first use of kerosene as illuminating fluid; early use of petroleum as lubricant on trains; use of gasoline as fuel for internal-combustion engines, which marked beginning of automobile industry; successful laying of 4-mile pipe line in 1865.

Reel 3 shows transportation of oil by specially constructed tank ships, improvements in driling methods—modern 2-ton "string" tool capable of forcing its way through earth and rock to depth of several thousand feet compared to tools weighing 300 pounds used by

Colonel Drake; steel rigs sometime reaching height of 136 feet compared to Drake rig 49 feet high. Pictures part played by petroleum during World War—its use in automobiles and army transport trucks, transportation of oil to Europe by tank ships. Shows pipe-line pump station; panorama of oil storage tanks, many of 80,000-barrel capacity; modern refineries embodying latest improvements in refinery practice; use of fuel oil in Diesel engines, and, instead of coal, on steamships and railroads. Reel closes with animated map of United States showing location of 110,000 miles of pipe line, and gives, by animation, statistics on oil consumption for 1890, 1918, and 1931.

*156 Nickel. 2 reels.

Reel 1 opens with a scene more than half a mile below the earth's surface, where nickel ore is being mined, loaded into cars, hauled to the bottom of the shaft, and crushed. Huge electric hoists bring the ore to the surface where it is crushed again, passed over a picking belt, pulverized in rod mills, concentrated by flotation, and smelted, in reverberatory furnaces and converters. Scenes that follow show spectacular operations of drawing the slag and tapping a cupola furnace, also electrolytic refining and casting.

Reel 2 portrays the increased importance of nickel alloys, chiefly those with iron steel, and copper. It shows the electric furnace in which the alloys are made, tapping the furnace, pouring into molds, and forging ingots. Other scenes portray handling of ingots, preheating of blooms, annealing furnaces, rolling mills, a pickling plant, and other incidental manufacturing operations. The film ends with several spectacular scenes showing how nickel is utilized in industry, in sports, and in the home.

*157 Making a V-Type Engine. 2 reels.

This picture shows unloading of ore boat, storage of iron ore, charging and tapping of blast furnaces, hauling of molten iron, charging electric or air furnaces, adding alloys, building molds, and casting molten iron. Other scenes picture heat treatment and machining operations on various parts of the engine, as well as checking the finished parts for accuracy. The picture

concludes with views showing assembly of the various parts to complete the engine, which is tested and placed in the chassis of an automobile.

Depicts fabrication in huge press where 5,000,000 pounds pressure is applied to hot-forge, pierce, and extrude billets. Scenes showing research and scientific studies being carried on in laboratory.
