DURING THE RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTY CONGRESS HELD 19-24 JULY 1965, THERE WAS ONE BILATERAL MEETING BETWEEN THE HEADS OF THE SOVIET AND COMMUNIST CHINESE DELEGATIONS, LEONID BREZHNEV AND TENG HSIAO-PING. IN THE PRESENCE OF LEADERS OF THE RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTY, THE TWO MEN SPENT THE BEST PART OF A DAY TOGETHER UNDER PLEASANT EXTERIOR SURROUNDINGS, "EATING, DRINKING AND WALKING THROUGH THE GARDEN," THEIR LIMITED DIS-CUSSION WHICH RESULTED IN NAUGHT WAS REMINDFUL OF A CAT AND DOG ACT. THEY ACCUSED EACH OTHER, INSULTED EACH OTHER AND ARGUED "LIKE TWO GYPSIES." ON THE ONE HAND, THE SOVIETS ACCUSED THE CHINESE OF BEING SCHISMATIC AND SPENDING ENORMOUS SUMS OF
