Subj: Allied Reply to Soviet Notes of March 19 re International
Charter Flights to Berlin

Ref : Bonn's 3757

1. United States Government approves text of draft note contained
refitel, on understanding fourth paragraph reads, "The proposals of 1945
referred to in the Soviet Government's note were concerned with an entirely
different question, namely the possible establishment of additional corridors.
These proposals had no connection with the use of the three corridors which
were actually established as is shown by the decisions taken on this subject
by the Allied Control Council."

2. When British and French Govts agree to text, three Embassies in Moscow
should coordinate delivery of notes. If British or French introduce major changes
in text, consideration of notes should be passed back to Bonn.
