The material collected by Mr. de Buisonjé on the island of Curação has now been sorted out, and we would very much appreciate, if you would identify our Ostreid. Can we send it to you to Houston?

This is the fossil I spoke about, which occurs in a limestone formation of uncertain age. Thes formation has usually been considered as quaternary. It is folded, and contains large quantities of secondary dolomite. Accordingly there are no microfossils. We have the impression that this limestone is pre-Quaternayy, possibly young Tertiary, but have no proof. We would be very pleased, if you could give us the name of the fossil, and, if possible, its age.
