SUBJECT: VISITS TO EAST BERLIN

AT JANUARY 3 MEETINV WITH WENDT, KORBER PRESENTED SENAT PROPOSAL AS OUTLINED REFTELS. KORBER SAID SENAT WOULD LIKE TO HAVE EAST GERMAN REACTION DURING JANUARY, STRESSING THAT REPLY NOT URGENT. WENDT STATED HE WAS AUTHORIZED ONLY TO DISCUSS MATTERS PERTAINING TO CURRENT CHRISTMAS PASS ARRANGEMENTS BUT WOULD TRANSMIT SENAT PROPOSALS TO HIS AUTHORITIES. FINAL KORBER-WENDT MEETING TO DISCUSS TECHNICAL PROBLEMS ARISING FROM CHRISTMAS PASSES SCHEDULED JANUARY 4.

AT PRESS CONFERENCE THIS AFTERNOON, SENAT PRESS CHIEF BAHR DENIED THAT SENAT HAD MADE PROPOSAL TO EAST AND ALLEGED THAT CONSULTATIONS BETWEEN SENAT, FEDREP AND ALLIES STILL IN PROGRESS. HE SAID THAT NO KORBER-WENDT MEETINGS SCHEDULED BEYOND JANUARY 4.

SINCE SENAT NOT DIVULGING PROPOSAL TO PRESS, BRITISH PRESS OFFICER (CHAIRMAN ALLIED SPOKESMAN) WILL SAY NOTHING BEYOND STATEMENT THAT ALLIES BEING CONSULTED.
