A.B. 06 Modification of Attendance Requirements

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED TO ACT

Modification of attendance requirements for Students' Assembly Representatives; now therefore

Be it enacted by the Student Assembly of the University of Texas that:

- SECTION I: Article IV, entitled, "Obligations of Representatives" of the Students' Assembly's "Internal Rules of Procedure," Section 3 is amended to read as follows:

 Section 3: Members of the Assembly are allowed four unexcused absences maximum
- SECTION II: Article IV entitled, "Obligations of Representatives,: of the Students' Assembly's Internal Rules of Procedure," Section 3, subsections A & B, are amended to read as follows:
 - A. After two unexcused absences the Attorney General shall place Assembly members on probation with the approval of the Internal Affairs Committee.
 - B. After four unexcused absences the Attorney General shall recommend expulsion to the Internal Affairs Committee. If the committee concurs, the Assembly shall vote on expulsion.
- SECTION III: To Article IV, entitled "Obligations of Representatives," of the Students' Assembly's Internal Rules of Procedure, Section 4, add a subsection D. This subsection shall read:
 - D. No more than one excused absence per month shall be allowed for any Student Government meetings or activities. Any excused absences in excess of one will be considered unexcused absences.
