BATTLING SULLIVAN IN R.A.F.

Boxing "fans" will be interested to learn that "Battling Sullivan," who recently returned after two years' service in Malta, is now boxing team instructor, with the rank of sergeant, at an R.A.F. Technical Training Command station in the north-west.

A native of Preston, Sullivan will be remembered at the ringside for his last big fight with Tommy Farr for the English championship, and for his performance against Max Schmeling in the world's championship contest at Berlin in 1929.

Now on a training course at the same station are Ronnie Clayton, generally conceded to be one of the best three bantamweights in the country, and Vale, the welterweight, both of whom are serving in the Fleet Air Arm.
