A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

Be it enacted by the Assembly of the Student Government of the University of Texas

Section One: Increasing Appointment Transparency

Append Section 9 to Article I of the Internal Rules:

Section 9: Appointments

A. All appointment applications shall be available for public inspection. B. The Assembly shall be given copies of the appointment application for each student appearing for confirmation.

C. Each person selected for confirmation and the number of applicants for the position to be confirmed shall be

included in the relevant agenda. D. All applications will be required to Signaforan in the Sboffice D. All applications will be required to Signaforan in the Sboffice by the required deadline Amend Section 5 of Article XXVIII of the Internal Rules as follows:

Section 5: The Executive Director shall monitor attendance requirements of representatives and agency directors, and execute appropriate sanctions for failure of compliance. Cumulative meeting attendance and voting records shall be posted online each week in spreadsheet format.
