Perhaps the enclosed check list of types of Lower Cretaceous echinoids supposed to be at Austin may help in replying to my rather indefinite request of February 24. A good many of the species are probably synonyms.

I think I shall be able to return more than half of those on the list within a few weeks; the others I shall need to retain longer, for I have not yet worked up the groups to which they belong.
