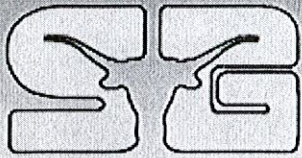

Whereas have been distributed on the University of Texas at Austin campus by the white supremacist group, National Alliance, multiple times.

Whereas : Flyers have been distributed on the University of Texas at Austin campus by the white supremacist group, National Alliance, multiple times.

Whereas Dr. Larry Faulkner has expressed discontent with the distribution of these fliers throughout campus, stating: "This outside organization has no right to speak on the campus and, to the best of our ability, we will enforce the rules that exclude this organization from campus."

Whereas Hate groups like the National Alliance, will not be tolerated on the UT-Austin's 40 Acres.

Whereas On April 27, 2000, Dr. Larry Faulkner gave an official response to a similar incident that involved the National Alliance distributing racist propaganda, stating, "This administration remains committed to fighting intolerance and bigotry on the campus of the University of Texas at Austin by all legal means."

Whereas In April of 2000, the University of Texas at Austin Administration informed the National Alliance that the dissemination of such materials was a violation of University regulations, and that the distribution of racially derogatory flyers should cease immediately.

Whereas On September 24, 2003, the National Alliance posted racially derogatory signs throughout the campus—after they had been told multiple times that such actions will not be tolerated on the University of Texas at Austin campus.

Be It Resolved The Student Government of the University of Texas at Austin shuns the messages of hate that national organizations, like the National Alliance, as well as some student organizations, have used to pollute the University of Texas at Austin campus.

Be It Further Resolved The Student Government of the University of Texas at Austin demands Dr. Larry Faulkner to take more immediate action than just contacting the National Alliance, through legal remedies, to prevent the reoccurrence of such actions and propaganda from entering the University of Texas at Austin campus.
