EXTENSION OF THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF MEMBERS OF
FOOD CONTROL COMMITTEES

The Minister of Food has decided to make certain amendments to the Order governing the Constitution of Food Control Committees in the light of the experience gained since these Committees were first established in September 1939.

The new Order will provide among other things that the appointments of all members shall take effect on January 1. Under the existing Order, the majority of members take up their appointments during September, and in order to relieve the Local Authorities of the obligation of making further appointments within a few months the Minister has made an interim Order extending the terms of office of all members now serving on Food Control Committees until December 31, 1942.
