AN ACT

AFFILIATING THE STUDENTS' ASSOCIATION AS A MEMBER OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS STUDENT GOVERNMENT ROUND TABLE AND AFFIRMING THE 1983 CHARTER OF SAID ORGANIZATION; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS:

Section 1. Findings. The Student Senate finds that there is a need to exchange information, ideas and viewpoints concerning student issues and student services within the various University of Texas System institutions; that coordination of joint activities within the among System institutions is lacking; that it is important to have a forum for student opinion; and that there presently exists no mechanism to present the collective voice of all students enrolled within the University of Texas System to all related constituencies.=====

Section 2. Affiliation. Pursuant to the findings in Section 1 of this Act, the Students' Association of The University of Texas at Austin is hereby affiliated with the University of Texas Student Government Round Table.=====

Section 3. Affirmation and Support. The principles enunciated in the 1983 are affirmed as legitimate goals for the Round Table. (a) Any new principles expounded by the Round Table must first be approved by the Senate before the President may authorize support by the Students' Association of those new Principles. (b) The President is responsible for representing the Students' Association in the Round Table and for Implementing the provisions of this Act.=====

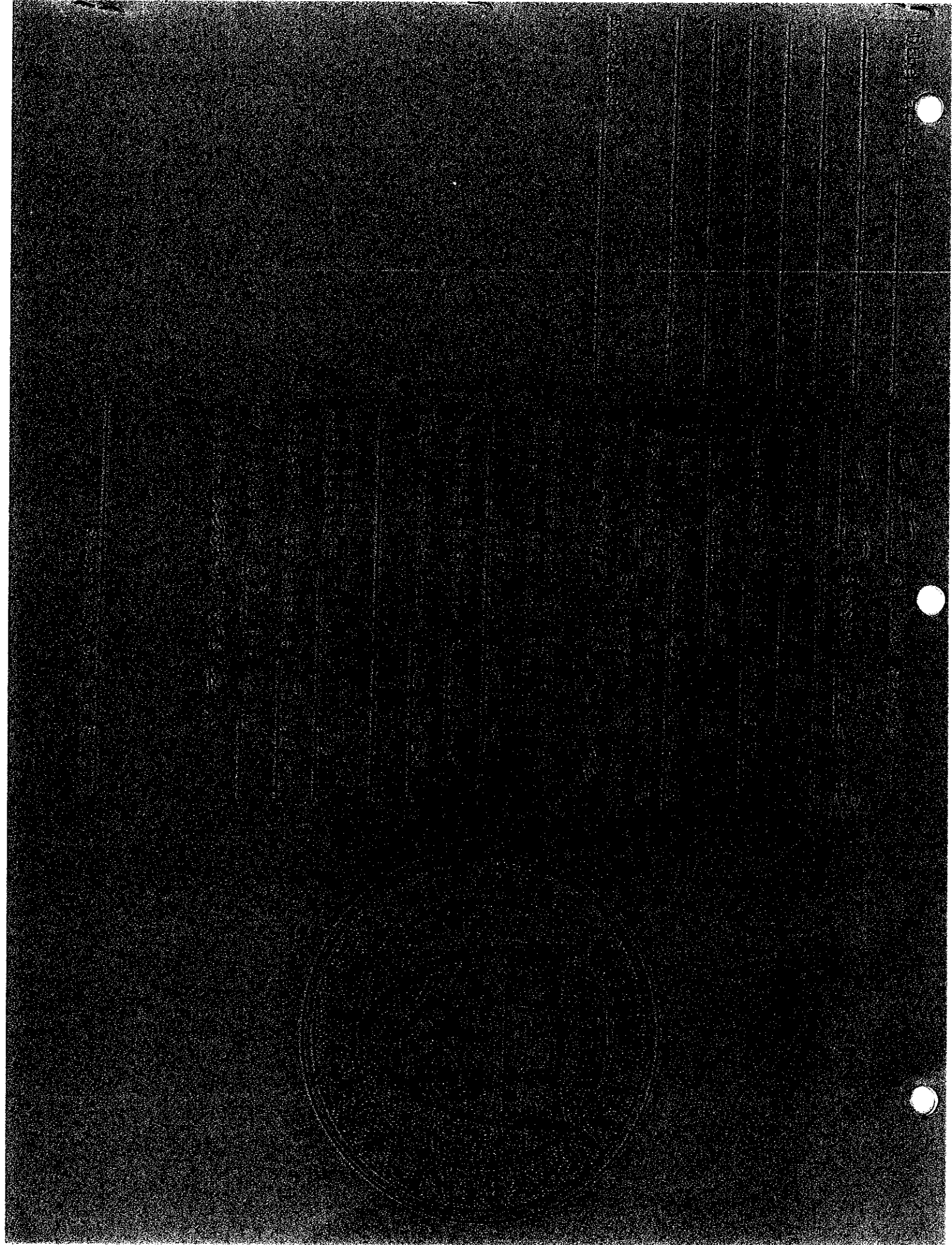
