I am settled in Moscow for 1/2 year now -
am beginning to go thru Paleogene faunal
literature & noticed a couple of things you
might be interested in following up: -

Vyalov, O. C. - in Paleontologicheskii ~~skop~~
sbornik 1, 1961 of Looz University -
there is an article on a critical study of
the group Gryphaea brogniarti Bonn -
In same publication is an article by a
fellow named Pasternak on systematics
U. K. jacksonids (of Ukraine).

In Paleontologicheskaya Zhurnal, no. 2, 1960
(Acad. Sciences USSR) there is an
article with almost same title as
Pasternak by a fellow named Собеткин
(i.e., Sobetsky). You can
probably run these down on library loan
from Rice or Texas - if you want, perhaps I
can get them for you, although that is hard -
They don't have the "separate" chapters and -
so books are out of print as soon as the ink
dries as a rule -

It's an interesting experience here - I have
Russian lessons 2 hours daily. By November I
should know some things.

We will relocate next winter. I have heard of a chance w. the USGS in California which sounds good. Al Fischer advises me strongly to follow up on it. But I have also had a nibble from Tripoli, Libya w. an oil co. - & while I am not so keen on commercial work - it would offer a wonderful chance to: 1) Stay in Europe
2) see the Mediterranean countries
3) save money -
4) watch Africa evolve politically -

I have met many Africans here - & their enthusiasm is infectious. The Sudanese in particular are extremely bright - there are over 1209 here - most studying medicine -

We keep you posted as news here as it develops. We look into the matter of the policy pods as soon as I can -
