## **A.B.21 Bylaws Change on Obligations of Representatives**

### **A BILL TO BE ENTITLED TO ACT**

REVISING AND CLARIFYING THE OBLIGATIONS OF REPRESENTATIVES; NOW THEREFORE

*Be it enacted by the Student Assembly of the University of Texas that:*

**SECTION I: Article VII Section 3 shall be restructured as follows:**

**Section 3: Members of the Assembly are allowed six absences maximum.**

**A. After four absences the Attorney General shall place such Assembly members on probation with the approval of the Internal Affairs Committee.**

**B. After six absences the Attorney General shall recommend expulsion to the Internal Affairs Committee. If the committee concurs, the Assembly shall vote on expulsion.**

**C. Absences due to an Academic Test or a Review Session for such a test shall not be counted towards the six absences allowed.**

**SECTION II: Article VII Section 4 shall be restructured as follows:**

**Section 4: Excused Absences**

**A. Representatives missing any required activity shall submit their excuses to the chair of the Internal Affairs.**

**B. A Representative missing a meeting for a test or a review session, as defined in part C Section 3 of this Article, shall have his/her instructor fill a for verifying the Representatives's attendance.**

**C. Such forms shall be made available by the Attorney General.**

**D. Representatives have to submit their forms to the chair of Internal Affairs within three days of the test or review session.**

**E. Internal Affairs shall approve or deny any excuses according to the standards established by the Assembly President**

**F. Representatives may appeal the decision of Internal affairs to the Assembly.**
