CITY RELATIONS AGENCY

Section 1: The City Relations Agency Director shall provide a formal channel of

communication between students, city government, neighborhood organizations, Capital Metropolitan Transportation Authority, county

officials, and The University of Texas at Austin Parking and

Transportation Services.

Force, which is to include the following Student Government affiliated members:

D. Chair of the Legislative Affairs Committee

E. Architecture School Representative

F. Two additional City Relations Agency members selected by the City
