## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

## ESTABLISHING A STUDENT GOVERNMENT AD HOC COMMITTEE TO COORDINATE AND PROMOTE AN ORGANIZED EFFORT TO INFORM STUDENTS ABOUT FINANCING AND FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITIES FOR PROJECTS AND EVENTS

- Section 1: The purpose of this Ad Hoc Committee would be to coordinate an effort to inform student organizations about the variety of methods to fund student initiatives.
- Section 2: The ad hoc committee will produce an attractive, informative, FREE MONEY brochure outlining student group funding sources and the general guidelines for receiving funding.
- Section 3: The committee will organize and host a FREE MONEY forum, open to all registered student organizations, that will include presentations on the various funding processes.
- Section 4: The committee will work closely with Campus & Community Involvement to inform student groups about guidelines and restrictions for fundraising.
- Section 5: The committee chair will be appointed by the President.
- Section 6: The FREE MONEY committee would be open to all interested and eligible students at the University of Texas at Austin.
