SUBJECT: CZECHOSLOVAKIA

I. I MET THIS AFTERNOON WITH DEPUTY FORMIN RAUL NASS TO DISCUSS LATEST DEVELOPMENTS RE CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND LEFT WITH HIM SUMMARIES OF DEPARTMENTAL SITREPS AS WELL AS BOHLEN BRIEFINGS AND RELATED MATERIAL.

2. NASS, RECENTLY RETURNED FROM MOSCOW AND EASTERN EUROPE, EXPRESSED SURPRISE ABOUT USSR ACTION. HE HAD BEEN ASSURED BY USSR FONMIN OFFICIALS THAT NO RPT NO REPRESSIVE ACTION WOUTLD BE TAKEN AGAINST THE LIBERAL CZECH REGIME OF DUBCEK. HE HAD BEEN SIMILARLY IMPRESSED BY SENSE OF COMPLETE NORMALCY AND OPTIMISM OF CZECHS DURING HIS VISIT THERE. YUGOSLAV DEPUTY FONMIN HAD TOLD HIM THAT USE OF USSR FORCE AGINST CZECHOSLOVAKIA WOULD SET BACK COMMUNIST MOVEMENT TWENTY YEARS. ROMANIANS HAD EXPRESSED SIMILAR SENTIMENTS.

3. NASS NOTED A GENERAL LATIN AMERICAN CONCER
ABOUT THE RETURN OF THE COLD WAS BECAUSE OF THIS USSR
ACTION AND AGREED THAT IMPACT IN EUROPE AND MID-EAST
COULD BE DANGEROUS. WE AGREED TO KEEP IN CLOSE CONTACT
AS NEW DEVELOPMENTS UNFOLD.
