A.B. 32 Limiting Appropriations Amounts to Student Services Fee Entities

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To modify the Internal Rules of Procedure for the Student Government of the University of Texas at Austin:

Be in enacted by the Assembly of the Student Government of the University of Texas at Austin:

SECTION I: Amend the Internal Rules of Procedure for the Student Government of the University of Texas at Austin, Article IV, by inserting the following after Section 9, Subsection D., and renumbering the following subsections:

E. The monetary value appropriated to a Student Services Fee entity for a given appropriations term shall not exceed five percent of the total amount allocated by the Assembly for appropriations during that term. A "Student Services Fee entity" shall be defined in this context as an organization, planning committee, student group, etc. that has received funds directly from the Student Services Fee Committee toward the entity's same budget for which appropriations are being requested from Student Government. The Assembly Appropriations Committee shall adhere closely to this rule in making its final recommendations to the Assembly. A 2/3 vote of the Assembly Representatives present shall be required to suspend this rule in order to consider an amendment to increase the amount of appropriations for a Student Services Fee entity above the amount allowed in this rule.

SECTION II: This bill shall not go into effect until April 1, 2000.
