1. United States Government approves text in reftel for US note to Soviets, subject to following: In third para of text, first word in citation of Bundesbahn regulations should be corrected to read ~~KXXX~~ "Vorlaeufige."
2. When UK and France agree to text of shortened version of US note, Embassy Moscow should coordinate delivery of notes with their Embassies. Bonn and Dept should be informed when notes delivered.
3. Since Soviets have not published their note, we do not at this time plan to publish our reply. END
