Passed 4-28-92

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT ASSEMBLY OF THE STUDENTS' ASSOCIATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT AUSTIN: that the Students' Association support Clean Commute Day and Bike to Work Day, coincident events on Thursday May 7, 1992, and we ask each member of the University community to attempt to reduce her or his "one-person-to-a-car driving" on that day.
