Dear Miss Kuhn

I had your letter yesterday and Sir John's this morning. And ~~in~~ turn shall quote "So ~~you~~ will you please of what Miss Kuhn can put at your disposal with the usual acknowledgements in due course. . . . word? The collection I am presently making is only by word, though with the use of a second piece of material the results of a collection by each character can be obtained though with more work.

If I may make a start then with the duplicate plates, I may be able to get for enough - supposing they have a reasonable selection of the hands - to be able to do the rest with less wear and tear on your tracings and photos. My interest in preserving their condition is quite as great as yours because they're all I have too!
