ATHENS Sept. 25. 1983

Dear Emmett,

In Athens you can, if you like, stay, with  
Tom (if he likes) in my apartment.

It was very nice to have your news. I have already answered  
to Tom and referred to him some ideas I have about your  
trip too. I was very busy before leaving for Cyprus a "terra  
ignota," but finally all has gone rather smoothly and with  
some success. I know you very well. You are not a perfect  
procrastinator (Thanks for the word not known to me before.)

- Now I remember I asked you about asbestos in Greece is ἀφίατον.  
You are procrastinator like Mediterranean people and so I believe  
that with Tom aside you will go on considerably. He inspires  
me too. This is you know ἀφίατη not gelousy, quite different.  
(Εγενής ἀφίατη).

I was told by Margherita that "proofs" of my article have been  
received at Rome not yet in Athens! I hope tomorrow,  
Cyprus was wonderful and contacts there quite useful. Now I  
prepare my application for membership ΕΤΑΙΡΟΣ of the Archaeological  
Society. Paper of a rather high level. In my paper about  
"Production and Economy in 14-13<sup>th</sup> century Cyprus: Between The Aegean  
and The Near East." I suggested an agricultural/livestock  
production and economy basis along to exports of Copper, Timber  
etc. and a Central Authority (one or more) with centralized  
economic system and Administration company with  
indirect evidence for the contemporary Minoan-Mycenaean-Ugarit  
systems. Just a framework to put in new data (see the  
huge building in Kalaureas, Hamm Vounos and Kitim).

Now, finally: My schedule for the fall and early winter  
as my desiderata:

October till Dec. elections (we have 5<sup>th</sup> November) in Athens and  
Thebes (in service)... Do you believe it?

Nov.-Dec. (I hope) in Rome with epidenia (επιδημία)  
They, in poor words if you come 22 or later I can accompany  
you by train Rome - Reggio Calabria or by plain the same,  
and see with you Reggio - Metaponto - Taranto - Lecce for 2-3  
days and then return to Rome and join Tom, also by  
26 Nov. arrives and stays for 4 days till Nov. 30. In this  
case we can pass a night at Rome in my apartment  
and leave the next day (22 or 23 as you like). Then  
you return to Rome or you leave via Brindisi (Via Appia)  
for Patras. I have never seen these places and I can do  
this now. We can easily ask help by colleagues in the local  
Museums or in the University of Lecce (Dimitri Schilardi has  
a contact here). Anyways I promise you I will not speak  
about churches or tablets. We can read novels travelling.

You know that I have any reasons because I am rather  
"wounded" from the silence of some colleagues who decided  
my "exclusion" from the Hyc. Meetings. This hurts me but  
does not discourage me to continue! <sup>Notwithstanding the fact that,</sup> ~~they don't happen in~~  
a critical moment in which I have to choose between  
the smooth career of the field archaeologist <sup>(without family)</sup> or the "closed-  
minded" politics of <sup>our</sup> Italian colleagues... Some <sup>firms</sup> <sup>Movemb.</sup> ALKPIA  
only sorry... I believe I will manage to be ~~about~~ <sup>from</sup> 7-10

On your question about Hellenic possibilities Yes I agree with you. This (the Hellenes) was a fine in its artistic aspect civilization but very poor it seems in refinements in organization and bureaucracy making. It is like comparing Athens and the Roman Empire and Hittites had an Empire. And they were not sensible with fishes dolphins and octopuses or with birds etc. They like their neighbors Assyrians were terrible warriors and written on clay and wood lots of good and bad things.

Greece has never seen arches well organized after the Hyc. times (inspired from the Orient) till the times of the Venetian rule (they were Westerns).

I am full of enthusiasm in the idea that I meet you in November. OK. We are in Rome and with great pleasure you stay with us. (26-30 Nov.). I hope to be in Rome for Nov. 6th if the elections here will be on Nov. 5. Normally I had to stay with epidemia (Nov-Dec.) now I stay Nov. 5-Jan 1990, ~~in~~ in Rome. So I stay with you in Rome but not in Athens. I can give you and Emmet my apartment there if you like.

But I have only a problem. Emmet now in Austin wants to visit South Italy (the heel). and passes around or through Rome on Nov. 22.
