1. FOLLOWING INFORMATION MAY BE USEFUL IN APPROACHING GOVT'S; IT UPDATES REFTEL ON PUBLIC STATEMENTS BY AFRICAN GOVERNMENTS OR HEADS OF STATE WHICH CRITICAL OF SOVIETS:

ZAMBIA: PRESIDENT KAUNDA TERMED SOVIET INVASION "IMPERIALISTIC ACT OF NAKED AGREESION...SO CHILDISH, SO STUPID".

GHANA: NATIONAL LIBERATION COUNCIL STATED 8/22 THAT GOG LEARNED OF INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA "WITH SHOCK AND DISMAY...THIS UNJUSTIFIED AGRESSION AND BLATANT INTERFERENCE IN INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, REMINISCENT OF EVENTS IN HUNGARY IN 1956, STRIKES SEVERE BLOW AT VERY FOUNDATION OF INTERNATIONAL LAW AND POSES SEVERE THREAT TO SECURITY AND TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY OF SMALL NATIONS."

KENYA: GOK 8/22 "CONDEMNS IN STRONGEST POSSIBLE TERMS THIS INVASION WHICH IS BREACH OF SOVEREIGNTY, POLITICAL INDEPENDENCE AND TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA ... 2. INCREASING AFRICAN PRESS CONDEMNATION OF SOVIETS WITH PARTICULARLY STRONG ATTACKS IN CONGO (K), KENYA, TANZANIA, ZAMBIA AND GHANA. NO AFRICAN GOVERNMENT HAS PUBLICLY SUPPORTED SOVIET ACTION ALTHOUGH SOME GOVT-CONTROLLED PRESS HAS CARRIED TASS OUTPUT (ALGERIA, MALI, SUDAN) AND OTHER PAPERS HAVE NOT EDITORIALIZED OR HAVE MINIMIZED VOVERAGE.
