AR 37--Supporting the Placement of Majors on Diplomas

A RESOLUTION

ENDORSING THE INDICATION OF MAJORS AND / OR CONCENTRATIONS ON UNDERGRADUATE DIPLOMAS FOR THE DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF ARTS.

WHEREAS all undergraduate diplomas at The University of Texas at Austin, with the exception of those for the degree of Bachelor of Arts, indicate the major and / or concentration in which the degree was earned;

WHEREAS many of The University's peer institutions indicate the undergraduate major and / or concentration on the Bachelor of Arts diploma;

WHEREAS the indication of major and / or concentration on a diploma would help to differentiate Bachelors of Arts from the College of Liberal Arts and the College of Natural Sciences;

WHEREAS the indication of double majors on the diploma would reward those students who accomplished both majors, and improve graduates' morale;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Student Assembly of the University of Texas at Austin endorses the following proposal to University of Texas President Larry R. Faulkner:

That the Office of the Registrar be directed to devise a system of indicating majors and / or concentrations on diplomas for the degree of Bachelor of Arts at the earliest possible time.
