AB22: Changing Bylaws – Secretary of the Assembly to Administrative Director

Article V  
STIPENDS

- Section 1: President is eligible to receive an annual stipend not to exceed six thousand eight hundred forty dollars (\$6,840.00) or five hundred seventy dollars (\$570.00) a month and a payment of tuition and fees not to exceed five thousand two hundred dollars (\$5,200).
- Section 2: The Vice-President is eligible to receive an annual stipend not to exceed three-fourths of the President's and a payment of tuition and fees not to exceed five thousand two hundred dollars (\$5,200).
- Section 3: The Executive Director, External Financial Director, Internal Financial Director, Communications Director, and Administrative Director are eligible to receive annual stipends. The amount of each stipend shall not exceed one half of the President's stipend.
- Section 4: Each Student Government officer and agency head is eligible to receive an annual stipend.
- Section 5: Each Student Government officer and agency head that receives an annual stipend may not exceed  $\frac{3}{5}$  of that of the Student Government President.
- Section 6: All officers receiving stipends shall be responsible for demonstrating adequate work each month (at least 100 hours for Student Government President and Vice President and 40 hours for all others) before the Internal Financial Director may release payment.
- Section 7: The Assembly may reduce, suspend, or eliminate the stipend of any officer at any time during the year should that officer fail to fulfill the responsibilities of the office. This shall require a two-thirds vote of the Assembly.
- Section 8: The President and Internal Financial Director shall be responsible for designating the amount of each stipend per year when preparing the budget, subject to the approval of the Assembly.
- Section 9: Any Student Government Agency that has submitted a proposal to the Vice President of Student Affairs to become a university department is exempt from Article V, Section 5. If the agency's proposal is rejected, they are no longer eligible for this exemption.
- Section 10: A Representative is not eligible to receive a stipend from Student Government.
