A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ACCESS CHANNEL ON AUSTIN CABLE VISION FOR EXCLUSIVE USE BY KVR9-TEXAS STUDENT TELEVISION

WHEREAS: The Texas Student Television is the Nation's first completely student run low power FCC regulated Television station.

WHEREAS: The Texas Student Television Station has expanded from producing three hours of programming a week one year ago, to producing eight hours of programming a week currently.

WHEREAS: The current mode of broadcasting for TSTV, which is inaccessible to television viewers who have cable, severely constrains the ability for KVR9 to reach a majority of its audiences.

WHEREAS: The necessity for student programming to be able to be accessed by the student body is growing with the expansion of departmental programming such as the Business School CBA-TV.

WHEREAS: The Telecommunications Commission of the Austin City Council has approved the establishment of a Texas Student Television Channel on Austin Cable Vision.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Student Government calls for the establishment of a channel on Austin Cable Vision for exclusive use by Texas Student Television (KVR9).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

The Student Government calls for the continued support that KVR9 receives from the Student Services Fee Committee to remain functional.
