MEMORANDUM TO THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: NSC Meeting on Cyprus, Wednesday, January 24

You are scheduled to meet with the National Security Council on Wednesday to consider a strategy for the settlement of the Cyprus problem.

The meeting is scheduled for 12:30. We have just learned that Secretary Rusk is scheduled to appear before the ~~Senate~~ <sup>House</sup> Foreign *affairs* ~~Relations~~ Committee at 10:30 A.M. Wednesday. He wants to remain at that meeting until every question is answered so that there will be no excuse for calling him again. The chances are that Secretary Rusk will be on time for the meeting. If he is kept on the Hill, Nick Katzenbach can present the Cyprus paper.

The regular NSC attendees have been invited. I think it would be a good idea to ask Cyrus Vance to attend.
