 - i. The sums of money specified in the budget spreadsheet are appropriated as indicated for the operation of the Student Government at The University of Texas at Austin for the 2015 and 2016 academic school year.

- a. J.R. 1 In Support Of Creating A 30-Day Grace Period For Clearing Financial Academic Bars
 - i. JR 1 is written to address student concern over financial bars inhibiting timely registration. This legislation calls for a 30-day grace period during which students can pay their fees and maintain their listed registration times.
- b. A.R. 10 In Support of a University-Wide Effort for Increased School Spirit
- i. UT Student Government supports initiatives to increase school spirit on campus.

 These can be student lead, or in this first case. Government Representative. Enthusiasm and school spirit have been proven to be lower than in past years and ticket sales are also down. UT Athletic Officials have made it clear how hard it is to excite such a large campus. With this

resolution, we are showing that we stand in solidarity with UT Athletics and their efforts to reinvigorate the student body through fresh, innovative ways.

- c. A.R. 11 In Support of Student Government Hosting an Annual Debate between Campus Political Groups
 - i. This legislation calls for the creation of an annual debate between campus political groups. This event will be sponsored and moderated by Student Government and The Daily Texan. All of the necessary expenses, which will be few or none, are expected to come from the special projects budget. This year, the debate between College Republicans and University Democrats will be held on the evening of October 12th.
- d. A.B. 5 Establishing Outreach Points
 - i. AB 5 establishes requirements for representatives in the Assembly outside of the pre-existing committee/Assembly meeting requirements. AB 5 calls for the creation of 2 inreach point requirements per long semester of a representative's term, with inreach points being those outlined activities that promote the work of SG agencies, ad hocs, and external appointments. AB 5 also calls for the reinstitution of outreach points (2 per long semester of term) previously present in the 108th Assembly. Those outreach events are defined in the bill as events put on by groups that have received SG funding within that same semester. It should be noted that attendance at one event correlates to one inreach or outreach point respectively.
